Key Responsibilities and reporting lines.

1. Reports to the Chief Lecturer, Flight Operations training
2. To carry out trainings in accordance with the Flight Operations course syllabus, schedules and as per the ATO course delivery procedure.
3. Shall also ensure that the trainee records of attendance, appropriate training records such as, course notes, schemes of work, lesson plans are available and updated as necessary.
4. Set examinations and Conduct assessments
5. Responsible for implementation of quality targets.

Minimum Qualifications requirements for an instructor applicant as per KCAR and approved Training Manual

1. Holder of a ***valid*** Flight Operations Officer License and that applicant has performed his/ her duties in the six months preceding the date of application for renewal while exercising the privileges of the license.
2. Documentary evidence that the applicant has the experience or training as follows
 - a) a total of two years' service in any one or in any combination of the capacities specified in sub-paragraph (i), (ii), (iii), provided that in any combination of experience the period served in any capacity shall be at least one year.
 - i. a flight crewmember in commercial air transport; or
 - ii. a meteorologist in an organization dispatching aircraft in commercial air transport; or
 - iii. an air traffic controller or technical supervisor of flight operations officer or air transportation flight operations systems;
 - b) At least one year as an assistant in the dispatching or aircraft used in commercial air transport; or
 - c) Has satisfactorily completed an approved course training in flight operations.
3. Documentary evidence the applicant has received training in the teaching and instructional techniques.
4. Demonstrable teaching experience in subject(s) related to Flight Dispatch.
